- Increase in unemployment
- Effort to turn workers against workers
- Plan to reduce the social state

Needs pyramid of Maslow

- Our needs are hierarchical
- In the basis of the pyramid there are the physical needs, then the need for security, then the need to belong somewhere, then the need to be recognised and estimated and last the need for selfactualisation
- Needs of the lower levels are more demanding. As a principle they have to be met first to step up the pyramid
